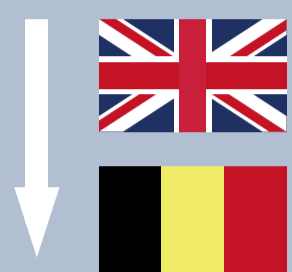


TRAVEL UPDATE FOR UK TRAVELLERS TO BELGIUM AS OF 18 FEBRUARY 2022

All travel is permitted for individuals who are fully vaccinated

In case you travel via France, fully vaccinated travellers must provide proof of vaccination and will be required to have complete a 'sworn statement' form self-certifying they are not suffering from symptoms associated with coronavirus.

STEP 1
Complete a **UK Passenger Locator Form** in the 48 hours before you arrive in England

STEP 1
Complete a **UK Passenger Locator Form**

STEP 2
Undertake a **pre-departure Lateral Flow or PCR test**

STEP 3
Book and pay for **COVID-19 PCR test** to be taken in the first 2 days after you arrive in England

STEP 4
When arriving in England you must take the **COVID-19 test** that you booked before you travelled

¹ Proof of vaccination status can be via the NHS COVID Pass, the EU Digital COVID Certificate or an equivalent digital pass. A printed certificate containing a QR code is also acceptable.

² Acceptable negative tests include a RAT-test taken within 36 hours prior to travel or a PCR-test taken 72 hours prior to travel.
